
## 2d-Largest Class Enrolls At U.S. Naval Academy

The second-largest class in the history of the U.S. Naval Academy was sworn yesterday



Rear Admiral James Calvert, Academy superintendent. told members of the new class they represent the best of America's youth.

"More than 20,000 expressed an interest, 6000 qualified for nominations and some 1300 are here," he said.

Calling the event one of the great ceremonies of the American people, Calvert said that "very survivability of the America depends on quality of men who undergo this experience."

Capt. Lawrence Heyworth Jr., Commandant of Midshipmen, administered the oath of office to the candidates. Two foreign nationals, from the Philippines and Costa Rica, were sworn in at separate ceremonies.
