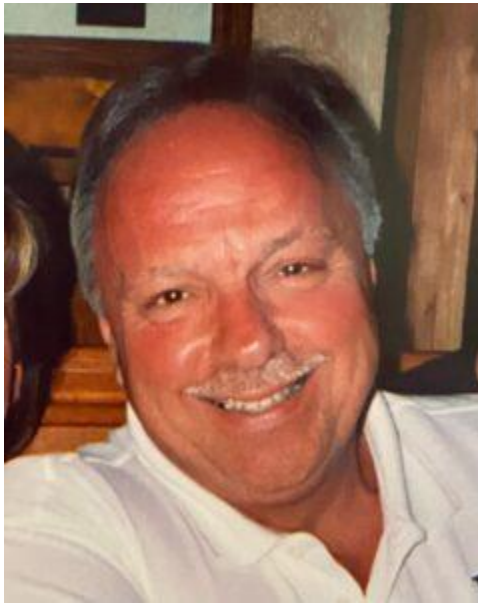


Obituaries
