I am writing in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of December 14, 2024, for records in the custody of the National Archives and Records Administration. Your request was received in this office on February 22, 2024, and assigned FOIA tracking number RD 78202.

We conducted a thorough search of the muster rolls for a contingent of Midshipmen from the US Naval Academy on the USS Dubuque (LPD-8) and the USS Vancouver (LPD-2) for June 8-11, 1972, and found 10 pages responsive to your request. These records have been redacted to protect personally identifiable information for living individuals per 5 USC 552 (b)(6). Copies are enclosed.

If you are not satisfied with our action on this request, you have the right to file an administrative appeal within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of this letter. Appeals must be in writing and may be delivered by regular U.S. mail or by email. By filing an appeal, you preserve your rights under the Freedom of Information Act and give the deciding agency a chance to review your request and reconsider its decision. If you submit your appeal by regular mail, it should be addressed to the Deputy Archivist of the United States (ND), National Archives and Records Administration, [8601 Adelphi Road, Room 4200, College Park, Maryland 20740 6001](#). Both the letter and envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." If you submit your appeal by email, please send it to foia@nara.gov, addressed to the Deputy Archivist, with the words "FOIA Appeal" in the subject line. Please be certain to explain why you believe this response does not meet the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act. All communications concerning this request should reference your FOIA tracking number.
